
MASTER OF MEDICAL SCIENCE Pathologists' Assistant

Students will be able to complete a two year program with a Master of Medical Science in **Pathologists' Assistant.**

What is a PA?

A Pathologists' Assistant is a highly trained, certified allied healthcare professional who is qualified by academic and practical training to provide various services in anatomic pathology under the direction and supervision of a licensed, Board Certified or Board Eligible Anatomic Pathologist. Pathologists' Assistants are academically and practically trained to provide accurate and timely processing of a variety of laboratory specimens, including comprehensive macroscopic examination and evaluation of all surgical pathological specimens. Pathologists' Assistants also perform postmortem examinations including prosection, assisting the Pathologist with rendering the provisional anatomic diagnosis, composing the clinical history, recording the macroscopic anatomic findings, and submitting tissue sections for microscopic examination. Pathologists' Assistants play a critical role in the delivery of healthcare services in both surgical pathology and autopsy pathology.

What makes Anderson University's MMSPA Program Unique?

The Master of Medical Science in Pathologists' Assistant (MMSPA) degree received approval, making Anderson University's program the first one in South Carolina and only the sixteenth such program in North America. The two-year program will be completed in a fully seated format with clinical rotations conducted at regional hospitals, free-standing pathology labs and forensic pathology labs. Educational prerequisites are a bachelor's degree in biology or a related field. Anderson University has also acquired the Anatomage Table that has 3 human cadavers that have been digitally uploaded to this 5-foot touch screen. This allows the student to dissect from the skin down to the bone and vascular system. This technology is used in conjunction with out physical cadaver lab on main campus.

The Master of Medical Science in Pathologists' Assistant (MMSPA) program is an 80 credit hour cohort based program. The Pathologists' Assistant is an allied health professional who is a mid-level healthcare provider. After completing the program, students will be eligible to sit for the American Society of Clinical Pathology (ASCP) Board of Certification exam, once the program is deemed a "serious applicant" by the National Accrediting Agency for Clinical Laboratory Sciences (NAACLS).

Requirements

Three letters of recommendation from individuals familiar with your academic background and performance are required. In addition, official copies of all college/university transcripts (undergraduate and, if applicable, graduate transcripts) are required. Graduate Record Examination (GRE) and Medical College Admissions Tests (MCAT) are not required for admission at this time. The applicant must be physically, mentally, and socially capable of taking on the required coursework and clinical rotations as well as qualify for the

ASCP-BOC exam.

Program Information

Admissions

A baccalaureate degree in chemistry or biological studies from an accredited institution is required. A baccalaureate degree in a non-science area will be considered if the applicant has taken the required science courses and the admissions committee deems them acceptable. The applicant is encouraged to demonstrate successful completion of science coursework including at least one semester each of the following: general chemistry, organic chemistry or biochemistry, biology (including introductory and at least one semester of upper-level biology coursework), mathematics (at least through algebra), and English composition. Classes such as anatomy, physiology, histology, and microbiology are highly recommended.

The student must have an overall undergraduate GPA of 3.0 or above. A science GPA of 3.2 or higher is recommended. A 500-word personal statement indicating why the applicant wants to be a Pathologists' Assistant and attend Anderson University is required. This letter should indicate personal experiences including, if applicable, any job-related experiences in the laboratory setting. Prospective student shadowing or other clinical experiences in an anatomic pathology laboratory (histology, surgical pathology, and/or autopsy) is highly recommended; however, this experience is not required for admissions consideration at this time.



COMPLETION TIME OF 2 FULL YEARS (24 MONTHS)




NATIONAL MEDIAN SALARY OF \$91,499
